




99% of the 63 million enterprises officially fall in the category of microenterprise based on investment and revenue criteria. However, the MSME Development Act, (2006) largely caters to the remaining 1% enterprises that comprise of small and medium businesses The micro group itself is characterized by heterogeneity, fragmentation and informalization. If we refine categories further, another separate grouping of entrepreneurs and enterprises can be carved out, which we can call nano-entrepreneurs.
